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














- I. Print labels & numbers. Cut. Laminate if desired.
- 2. Tape subject labels onto each drawer. (I like to use packing tape)
- Add Velcro to workboxes (rough side) and numbers (soft side).
 Add rough side Velcro to the progress chart also.
- 4. Attach the progress chart to the side of the cart.
- 5. Load up the drawers!
- 6. Teach your kids how to use the system. This is a very important step. DO NOT SKIP!

On-task charts


Beside the progress chart, you will find an on-task chart with 4 happy faces.

Clip a clothes-pin on the happy-face when you notice your student staying on-task and focusing well. Aim for I per hour.

Keep a daily tally and have special days when you reach goals.


For example: 30 clips = pajama day 45 clips = hat day 60 clips = crazy sock day 100 clips = ice cream





























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
