How to Prep

prep.

- l. Print cards on white cardstock.
- 2. Cut apart and put in ABC order.
- 3. Keep cards together with a ring, a clip, or a baggie.
- 4. Store in an easy-to-reach area (like the kitchen table or beside the bed)
- 5. Print handwriting sheets all at once or as needed.

How to Use

I. Aim to memorize I verse each week.

Every 4 weeks, do a review of all verses learned. Since there are 26 letters, if you put in several weeks of review in this way and 2 weeks of review at the end, it should take you about 34 weeks to learn the whole alphabet. See the suggested schedule in this document. A school year is usually 34-36 weeks, so it will be a delightful way to teach the alphabet to beginning readers or help older children to memorize 26 scriptures over the course of the school year.

2. Review All verses learned Daily.

In our home, we keep our Bible memory verse cards at the kitchen table. Every day during lunch, we recite the verses memorized together as we eat.

Study the meaning of the verses.

On Monday, I introduce a new verse and we read it in context. We think up fun motions to help us remember the words or set them to a little tune we make up. On Tuesday, we recite using the motions we made up and we discuss the meaning. On Wednesday and Thursday we continue to discuss the meaning: how it reminds us of other verses in scripture, and how we see it demonstrated in a Bible character or a Bible story. On Friday, we focus on how we can apply the scripture to our own lives. We compliment each other as we see someone in the family living out the verse. Sometimes we even keep tally marks when we see it demonstrated and make it into a game!

4. Review frequently!

The key to memorization is frequent review! Try to recite it as frequently as you feed your children (that's the reason we keep ours at the kitchen table). Feed their hearts!

Weekly Plan

Monday

- ✓ Introduce a new verse
- ✓ Read it in context in the Bible
- \checkmark Think up fun motions to help remember the words
- \checkmark Set the words to a little tune you make up
- ✓ Recite all previous verses

Tuesday

- ✓ Recite together using the motions you made up
- Discuss the meaning
- \checkmark Go around the table starting with A and have each child say a previous memory verse in order

Wednesday

- \checkmark Recite verse together with motions. Chunk it into 3 parts; repeat after mom.
- \checkmark Review or continue discussing the meaning of the verse
- ✓ Does this verse remind you of other scripture verses?
- ✓ Practice previous verses!

Thursday

- \checkmark Try reciting the verse alone each member of the family!
- ✓ How do you see this verse demonstrated in a Bible character or a Bible story?
- ✓ Practice previous verses!

Friday

- ✓ Recite the verse alone.
- \checkmark How can we apply the scripture to our own lives?
- ✓ Compliment each other as you see someone in the family living out the verse!
- ✓ Recite al previous verses. Who can say ALL the verses all by yourself?
